Her work included matters with significant congressional and media attention, particularly in the areas of sexual harassment and financial conflicts of interest.

Earlier in her career, Suzanne spent seven years at a large multi-national labor and employment law firm where she represented employers in federal and state courts in a broad range of employment matters. She also counseled clients on compliance, drafted workplace policies, and successfully defended numerous summary judgment motions and appeals.
